

How much time you think you have with your kids:




How much time with your kids actually works:





1. Honour your parents

1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), 3 "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land."

How to really provoke children to anger?

- Adopt a <u>critical spirit</u>
- Be <u>excessively strict</u>
- Allow your <u>irritability</u> to flow
- Embrace inconsistency
- Pick a <u>favourite</u> child

3. Discipline and instruct your children

How to ruin your kid in 5 steps

- 1. Beginning with infancy, give the child everything he wants.
- 2. When he picks up bad words, laugh at him.
- 3. Never give him any spiritual training. Let him wait until he's twentyone years old, and let him decide for himself.
- 4. Avoid using the word "wrong." It may cause him to develop a guilt complex.
- 5. Pick up everything he leaves lying around, so he will become experienced at throwing responsibility on everybody else.

"We feed children in order that they may soon be able to feed themselves; we teach them in order that they may soon not need our teaching. Thus a heavy task is laid upon Gift-love. It must work towards its



own abdication.
